Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; O lder, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$37,000 on the turf since August 27 Allowed 2 lbs. (Races where entered for \$35,000 or less not considered in allowances) (Preference by condition eligibility). Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Feb), by Langfuhr - Quiet by Roar. Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Michael Rankowitz & Susan Karches(NY).

With the starting gate set up to form a right angle with the outer fence, QUIET ENDING settled into midpack from off the inside, was asked for a response and undertook a decisive move to clear the fast-fading former pacesetter leaving the five-sixteenths pole, did so successfully and tucked along the rail prior to the quarter pole, cut the corner under strong handling and full of momentum, drew well of the others, many of whom had chosen a much wider route for entrance into the lane, and emerged from furlong grounds comfortably in front, maintained a healthy margin to the end, driving. DESERT BLISS unhurried for the opening half, fanned five wide for the commencement of the stretch drive, came home with good energy to procure the place. STRIKE ACCORD raced along the outside, was four wide at the head of the stretch, gained ground during the upcoming furlong, then flattened out a bit and was outfinished for the place. RODINIA in the two path and set down by the midway point on the turn, failed to muster up the needed response. DRINKSONTHEHOUSE made solid contact with CITY SCAMPER at the start, departed the backstretch from the three path, ranged up together with PRINCESS JENNY to overhaul the leader coming to the three-eighths pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. WHITE SANGRIA unleashed an abbreviated three wide run on the turn to achieve a good striking position by the three-eighths pole, failed to sustain it and tired. BONATINI got away two beats slow at the break, brought up the back of the pack for the opening half, got placed five wide at the top of the lane, made no impact. PRINCESS JENNY contently stalked CITY SCAMPER from off the inside down the backstretch, advanced when ready, with WHITE SANGRIA in tow one lane further to the outside, and went by the pacesetter to gain a narrow lead, relinquished soon afterwards and tired. DARN THAT TRIP had to travel more than half the width of the course to do so, but made it over to the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, took the inside route around the turn, was forced to steady, buried behind a tiring CITY SCAMPER nearing the quarter pole, found enough room and wiggled her way into the two path at the top of the lane, was asked for a response but didn't give any. PERSKY'S HEART raced near inside for over a half, got taken outward late on the turn until six wide by the head of the stretch, tired. CITY SCAMPER got bumped at the start but made the front nonetheless, commenced a long angle towards the inside and settled down there before reaching the half mile pole, got confronted by another pair halfway around the turn, relinquished despite being put to solid encouragement, and retreated.
